# What is an A+School?

While many Missourians see the A+ Program as a scholarship program, it was created by the Outstanding Schools Act of 1993 as an incentive for improving Missouri's high schools.

The primary goal of the A+ Schools Program is to insure that all students who graduate from Missouri high schools are well prepared to pursue advanced education and employment.

## Goals of an A+School...

- To ensure that *all students* graduate from high school.
- To ensure that *all students* complete a selection of high studies that is challenging and identifies learning expectations.
- To ensure that *all students* proceed from high school graduation to a college, a post-secondary vocational-technical school, or a high-wage job with workplace skill development opportunities.

### **#**+ Financial Incentives...

Students may be entitled to receive financial reimbursement if they meet all the requirements, if Francis Howell Central High School is granted A+ Schools status each year, and as state funds continue to be available.

## A+School Requirements...

- Enter into a written agreement with Francis Howell Central High School by September 1<sup>st</sup> of the student's senior year;
- Attend a designated A+ school for three consecutive years prior to high school graduation;
- Graduate from high school with a *grade point average (GPA)* of 2.5 or better;
- Maintain at least a *95% attendance rate* for the four-year period (miss less than 35 days);
- *Tutor* other students for *50 hours* on Francis Howell School District property, supervised by a Francis Howell School District employee, by January 1<sup>st</sup> of the student's senior year;
- Maintain a record of *good citizenship* according to the <u>State A+Schools Program</u>, <u>Francis Howell School District Code of Conduct</u>, and <u>Francis Howell Central High School Student Handbook</u>;
- Attempt to secure all available federal financial assistance funds that do not require repayment. During 12<sup>th</sup> grade, complete and submit the FAFSA form by April 1<sup>st</sup>. Parents may do this online at www.fafsa.ed.gov.
- Male students must register with the Selective Service upon their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday. Male students may register online at <u>www.sss.gov</u>;
- Enroll and attend a Missouri public community college or vocational/ technical school on a full time basis, while maintaining a GPA of 2.5 or better.



#### **A+** Student Benefits...

- College tuition to any of Missouri's public community colleges or public vocational/technical schools (based on FHCHS being granted A+ Schools status each year and the availability of state funds).
- Students may receive this incentive for a maximum of six (6) semesters and must be enrolled as a FULL-TIME student and maintain a grade point average of 2.5 or better on a 4.0 scale at the institution. Students are eligible to use the incentive for UP TO FOUR years after high school graduation.

## How Do I Apply for #+?

It's simple. Students and their parents/guardians should read over the agreement and be familiar with the requirements. The student and parent/guardian need to complete an A+ agreement form by September 1<sup>st</sup> of the student's senior year. The completed agreement should be returned to the A+ Schools Program office at Francis Howell Central High School to be processed.
